▲ 1885: Gilbert and Sullivan's Japanese-set operetta, *The Mikado*, was first performed in London

1820: Victor Emmanuel II, the first King to reign over a united Italy, was born

1983: OPEC cut oil prices for the first time in its 22-year history, Saudi light crude down from \$34 a barrel to \$29

1985: Keepers at Singapore Zoo put five lionesses on the contraceptive pill after a swift rise in the lion population from two to sixteen

2008: Several people were killed in Tibet's capital, Lhasa, in the largest protests in two decades against Chinese rule
