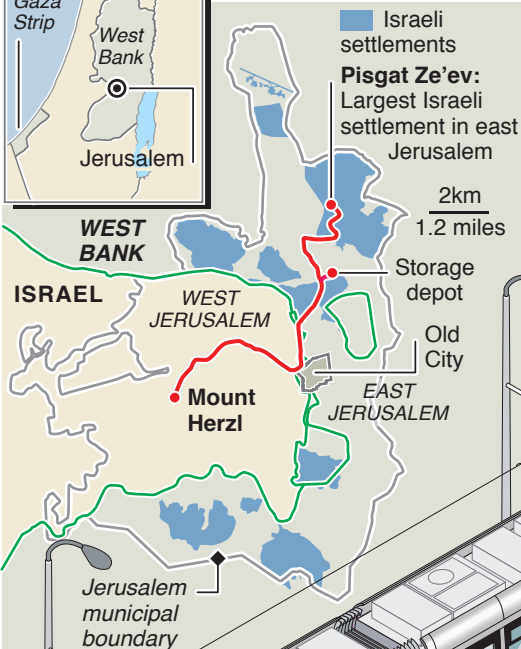


# Jerusalem light railway set to link divided city

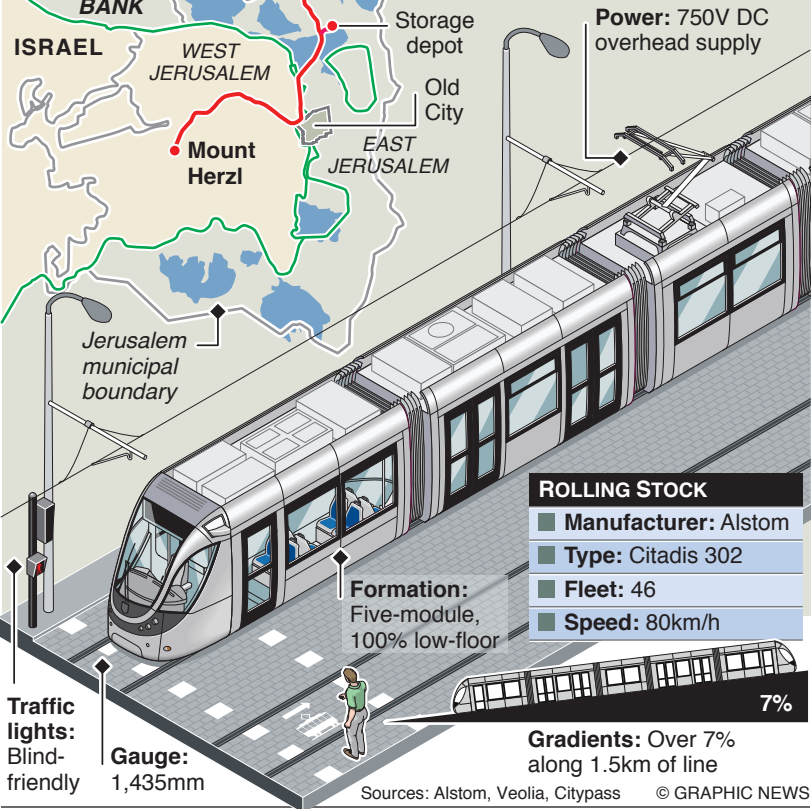
Jerusalem's first light railway is expected to start test runs this spring, promising to relieve the city's chronic congestion. But Palestinians say the \$1 billion tram is illegal, fearing that it will further entrench Israeli control over east Jerusalem



## LINE 1 "Red Line"

- Length: 13.8km
- Stations: 23
- Passengers: Around 30 million a year
- First of eight light rail lines planned across city

Power: 750V DC overhead supply



## ROLLING STOCK

- Manufacturer: Alstom
- Type: Citadis 302
- Fleet: 46
- Speed: 80km/h

Gradients: Over 7% along 1.5km of line
