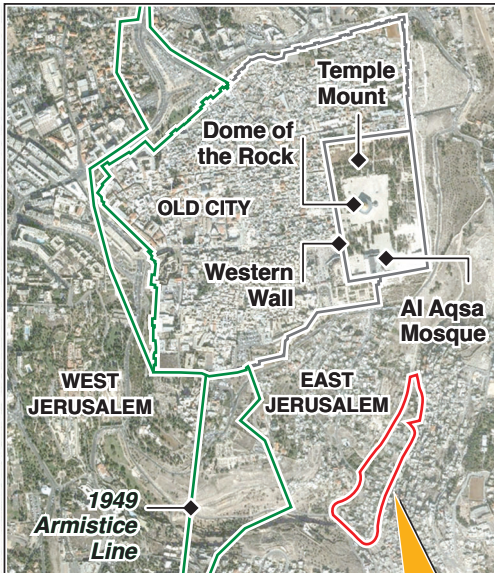


Shrines designated as heritage sites
