

# Deadly attacks in Iraq

**Mar 3, 2010:** Three suicide bombings in Baquba kill at least 31 people. The attacks come amid heightened tensions ahead of a crucial election, raising fears Iraq could slide back into sectarian violence

**Dec 2009:** At least 127 killed in series of car bombs in Baghdad

**Oct 2009:** Twin truck bombs kill 155 people in downtown Baghdad

**Aug 2009:** Suicide bombs hit Finance and Foreign ministries in Baghdad, killing more than 100 people

**Aug 2007:** Four bombs detonate simultaneously in Qahataniya, killing over 500 Kurdish-speaking Yazidis

**Jul:** Suicide truck bomb kills 160 in Turkomen village near Kirkuk

**Apr:** At least 183 killed in four bombings in Shia locations of Baghdad

**Mar:** Truck bombs at markets in city of Tal Afar kill 152



**Feb:** Suicide truck bomb in Shia area of Baghdad kills 137 people

**Nov 2006:** Mortar rounds and five car bombs kill 215 in Baghdad's Shia neighbourhood of Sadr City

**Sep 2005:** Multiple bombings in Baghdad kill 178 people

**Mar 2004:** Coordinated suicide bombings at Shia shrines in Karbala and Baghdad kill at least 181 people
