Dubai's *Meydan Racecourse* is the new home of the Dubai World Cup – the world's richest horse race. The futuristic venue, which cost an estimated \$2 billion to build, is the world's largest horse racing facility

Grandstand: More than 1km long, can accommodate up to 60,000 spectators. Includes 5-star hotel, restaurants, museum, theatre and covered parking for 10,000 vehicles

Tapeta course: Synthetic, all-weather surface. Length 8.75 furlongs (1,750m)
