

South Korean ship sinks

An explosion – possibly caused by a North Korean torpedo – ripped a hole in a South Korean Navy ship in disputed waters. Shots are reported to have been fired

Northern Limit line:

Recognised by South
Not accepted by North



Baengnyeong Island, 9.30pm:

1,500 tonne South Korean ship with 104 personnel on board starts to sink. Six naval ships and two coastguard vessels involved in rescue
