

- at Moscow State University

  1992: Becomes first ambassador
  to U.S. of independent Kyrgyzstan
- under President *Askar Akayev* 1994-97: Serves as Foreign Minister
- 1998-2001: Kyrgyzstan's first ambassador to Britain
- 2002-03: UN envoy to Georgia during Rose Revolution

2005: Instrumental figure in 2005

- "Tulip Revolution" that deposes
  Akayev and brings President
  Kurmanbek Bakiyev to power
- 2007: Becomes deputy for opposition Social Democratic party
- April 2010: After violent protests oust government, says she plans to head interim government for next six months to prepare new constitution
