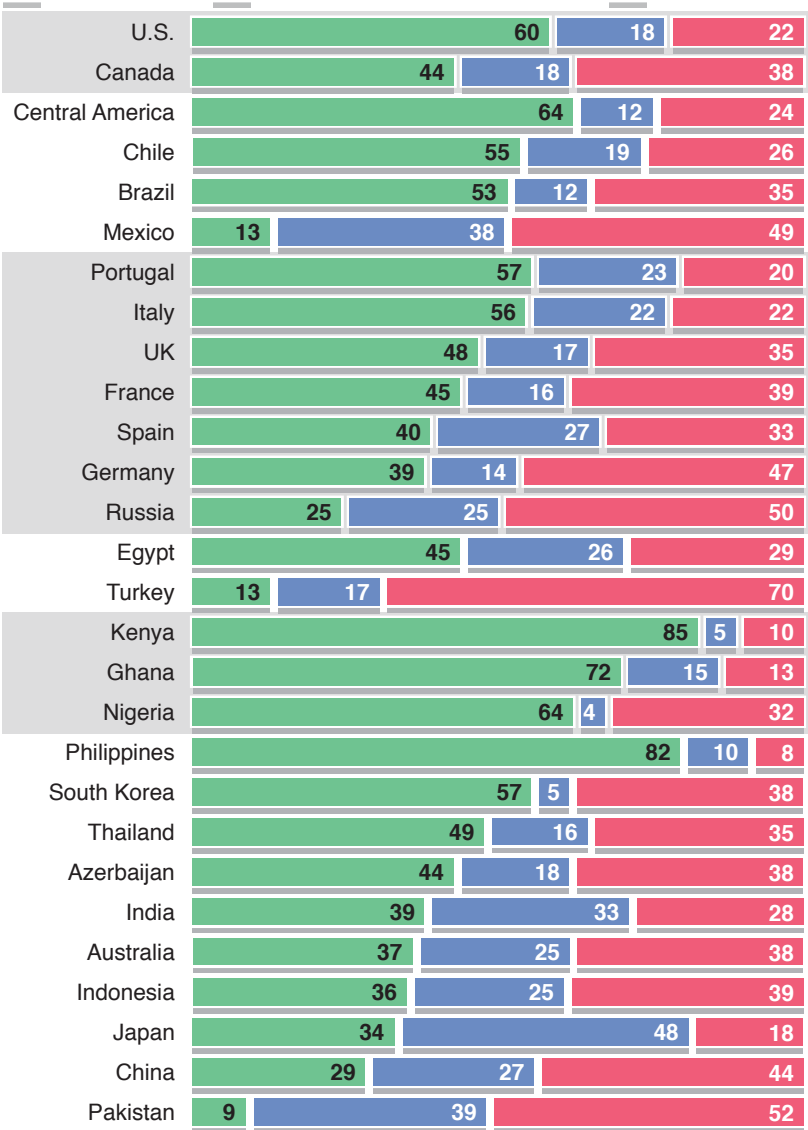


U.S. image improving abroad

International opinion of America's influence in the world has turned positive for the first time in five years, an annual BBC World Service poll shows. In 20 of the 28 nations polled, the U.S. was viewed favourably, with an average of 46% of the 30,000 adults surveyed saying its influence was positive
