
Al Pacino turns 70



- 1940: Born April 25, New York City ■ 1966: Studies at *The Actors*
- Studio under Lee Strasberg
- 1969: Makes Broadway debut, winning Tony Award for his role in Does a Tiger Wear a Necktie?
- 1972: Oscar-nominated as Michael Corleone in *The Godfather* only his third film. Reprises role in two sequels 1970s-80s: Major movie successes
- 1970s-80s: Major movie successes include Serpico, The Godfather Part II, Dog Day Afternoon, and Scarface
- 1992: Wins Best Actor Oscar for Scent of a Woman
- 2003: Wins Golden Globe and Emmy Award for *Angels in America*
- 2010: Half a dozen movies in preproduction, including *Dali & I: The Surreal Story* and adaptation of Philip Roth novel *The Humbling*
