1850: Joseph-Louis Gay-Lussac, French chemist and physicist who established the fact that all gases expand equally with heat, died

1946: King Victor Emmanuel III of Italy abdicated in favour of his son, who became Umberto II. The monarchy was abolished barely a month into his reign

2009: Jacob Zuma was inaugurated as President of South Africa
