

# Neanderthal genome sequenced

Researchers have sequenced the genetic blueprint of Neanderthals from bones found in Vindija, Croatia, and compared the genome with those of five present-day humans. The results reveal that 1-4% of human genes were derived from Neanderthals and the two species most likely interbred
