## **Lena Horne dies**



- Born: Brooklyn, NY, June 30, 1917
- 1933-38: Plays to packed houses at famed *Cotton Club* in Harlem
- 1942: First black performer to sign long-term contract with major Hollywood studio *MGM*
- 1943: Rendition of *Stormy Weather* in movie of same name brings fame
- 1947: Weds white bandleader Lennie Hayton, despite hostility to
- inter-racial marriage

  1960s: Actively involved in Civil
- Rights Movement
- 1981: Broadway show *Lena Horne: The Lady and Her Music*,
  wins special *Tony* award
- 1989: Receives *Grammy Lifetime*
- Achievement Award

   2006: Seasons of a Life, album of
- rare and unreleased recordings as well as signature songs, released

  May 9, 2010: Lena Horne dies
- at age of 92
