▲ 1989: Chinese army tanks moved into Tiananmen Square in Beijing, killing over 2,000 pro-democracy demonstrators, mainly students

1878: Turkey granted control of Cyprus to Britain

1946: General Juan Peron was sworn in as president of Argentina

1991: Albania's communist government, led by Fatos Nano, resigned after a 20-day general strike

2009: U.S. President Barack Obama delivered a keynote speech in Cairo, Egypt, calling for a "new beginning" in relations between the United States and the Muslim world
