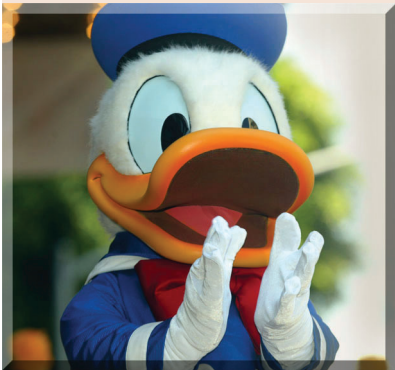

▲ **1934:** Cartoon character Donald Duck made his screen debut in *The Wise Little Hen*

**1672:** Peter I of Russia, who founded the city of St Petersburg, was born

**1874:** Apache Indian chief Cochise, who led Indian resistance to white settlers in the U.S. southwest, died

**1959:** The U.S. Navy launched the first submarine equipped with Polaris nuclear missiles

**2009:** A suicide vehicle bomb attack at the five-star Pearl Continental Hotel in the Pakistani city of Peshawar killed at least 17 people, including two UN employees
