

## David Cameron

- Born October 9, 1966: Aged 43, Cameron is just a few months younger than Labour Prime Minister *Tony* Blair was when he took power in 1997
- Education: Britain's most exclusive private school, Eton, and Oxford, where he gained a first-class degree in politics, philosophy and economics
- Career: Worked for centre-right Conservative party as adviser to then-Chancellor *Norman Lamont*. Public relations executive at Carlton television for seven years, before being elected to parliament in 2001. Became Conservative leader in 2005
- Family: Cameron's oldest child Ivan, who suffered from cerebral palsy and epilepsy, died in February 2009 aged six. Cameron and his wife Samantha dubbed Sam Cam by UK press have two children and are expecting a baby in September
