

Renegade Thai general shot

Khattiya Sawasdiapol, better known as Seh Daeng (Commander Red), the chief military advisor of Thailand's anti-government protesters, was shot in the head after security forces launched a crackdown on the red shirts' encampment



1 April 10: 25 people killed and at least 521 injured when Thai troops clash with thousands of red shirt demonstrators in Bangkok's worst political violence in 18 years

2 April 22: Rocket propelled grenades fired at troops from red shirt barricades at King Rama VI Monument. One person killed, 80 injured

3 Ratchaprasong: Some 10,000 protesters occupying upmarket shopping district for five weeks. Red shirts claim **Prime Minister Abhisit Vejjajiva** came to power illegally and want him to resign and call elections
