

# Renegade Thai general dies

General Khattiya Sawasdipol, the chief military advisor of Thailand's anti-government "red shirt" protesters, died on Monday. At least 65 people have been killed and more than 1,600 wounded since protests began in mid-March



**1 April 10:** 25 people killed and at least 521 injured when Thai troops clash with thousands of red shirt demonstrators in Bangkok's worst political violence in 18 years

**2 April 22:** Rocket propelled grenades fired at troops from red shirt barricades at King Rama VI Monument. One person killed, 80 injured

**3 May 12-17, Ratchaprasong:** 36 people killed in clashes between soldiers and protesters since Thursday. Red shirts claim **Prime Minister Abhisit Vejjajiva** came to power illegally and want him to resign and call elections
