- 1995: Released from house arrest but movements restricted2000: Returned to house arrest under
- State Protection Law. Released in 2002

 2003: Detained again following
- clashes between her supporters and pro-junta demonstrators

 2007: Greets protesting Buddhist
- monks marching past her house in first public appearance since 2003

 2008: House arrest extended for
- 2008: House arrest extended for another year
- 2009: Sentenced to 18 months further house arrest after uninvited visitor swims to her house
- Jun 19, 2010: Suu Kyi turns 65. NLD unable to participate in elections later this year owing to party's refusal

to accept junta's new election laws
