

Apr 6: Prime Minister Gordon Brown calls election. Parliament holds two-day "wash up" to rush through essential business

Apr 15: First of three televised debates between Brown, Conservative leader *David Cameron* and *Nick Clegg*, leader of Liberal Democrats

Apr 21: Employment statistics –

surge could dent Labour's hopes

Apr 22: Budget deficit figures due.

Reducing £167 billion deficit is main campaign issue. Second TV debate between Brown, Cameron and Clegg

Apr 23: GDP for first quarter 2010. Fall in growth – sign of "double-dip" recession – could be lethal for Labour

Apr 29: Final leaders' TV debate

May 6: Polling day

May 12-18: First session of new parliament
