BIRDS

■ **Brown pelican:**
Only removed from U.S. Endangered Species Act last year.

Breeding season on barrier islands has just started

■ Other bird species under threat include **Royal tern, Reddish egret, American oystercatcher, and Wilson's plover** (left)

5,000 barrels a day leaking into sea

FISHERIES

■ **Gulf Menhaden:**
Fishery of filter-feeder species is America's third largest. **Season for Mississippi and Louisiana opened April 19**

■ **Atlantic Bluefin Tuna:**
Critically endangered species at peak of spawning season

■ Shrimp and oyster industries face huge losses. **Oyster-gathering season in Louisiana starts May 1**

■ **Turtles:**
Several species of sea turtles currently moving through Gulf as spring nesting seasons start
