- Political career: Entered
- parliament in 1980. Founded Democratic Party of Japan (DPJ) with Hatoyama in 1998
- 1996: As Health Minister, Kan exposed government cover-up of HIV-tainted blood products that caused thousands of haemophilia patients to contract AIDS virus
- 2010: Appointed Finance Minister by Hatoyama. In his first news conference Kan surprised markets by advocating weaker yen to help exporters and stimulate economy
