## Gen Stanley McChrystal



- 1954: Born into military family
- 1976: Graduates from U.S. military academy at West Point
- 2003: Becomes commanding general of *Joint Special Operations Command* secretive body tasked with U.S. special forces missions abroad. JSOC troops capture former
- Iraqi president *Saddam Hussein* 2006: Promoted to JSOC overall
- commander

  2007: Linked to scandal over
- posthumous Silver Star awarded to former NFL football star *Pat Tillman*, killed in Afghanistan by friendly fire but whose death was initially attributed to enemy fire
- 2008: Becomes director of Joint Staff
- 2009: Takes over command of U.S. and NATO forces in Afghanistan. 30,000 extra U.S. troops deployed after he warns mission could fail within 12 months without additional forces
  - Jun 23, 2010: Gen McChrystal dismissed by U.S. President Barack Obama after critical comments about senior administration officials
