2001 David Duval USA 274 (-10) Royal Lytham & St Annes


 Duval's Delight: Brilliant last round of four under - together with rounds of 69 and 65 - leads inspired Duval to claim Claret Jug at 130th Open

Leading from 2nd round. Woods holds off challenges from Els, DiMarco and Furyk to clinch hat-trick of Open titles - his 11th major success



2003 Ben Curtis USA 283 (-1) Royal St Georges

 Debut Champion: Curtis consistently holds off Woods. Singh and. most notably, Bjorn, to become 1st first-time Open winner since Tom Watson in 1975
