Turkey-Israel fall-out



- Dec 2008: Turkish government, headed by AK Party which has Islamist roots strongly criticises Israel's offensive in Gaza Strip
- Jan 2009: Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan storms out of World Economic Forum in Davos, after clash with Israeli President Shimon Peres
- Jan 2010: Israel apologises over "humiliating" treatment of Turkish ambassador during meeting to protest Turkish TV series portraying Israeli agents as child kidnappers
- Jun 2: Ankara recalls ambassador from Tel Aviv to protest Israeli raid on Gaza-bound aid flotilla in which nine Turkish activists are killed
- Jun 28: Israeli military flights barred from Turkish airspace on case-by-case basis
- Jul 5: Turkey threatens to sever diplomatic ties with Israel unless it receives an apology over Gaza flotilla raid. Blanket ban on all Israeli military aircraft imposed
