- Raise aid through government channels from 20% to 50%
- Expand Afghan army strength to more than 170,000, and police to 134,000, by Oct 2011, allowing ISAF troops to leave by 2014
- Reintegrate up to 36,000 Taliban insurgents within five years
- Increase collection of domestic taxes to 9.4% of GDP by Mar 2011
