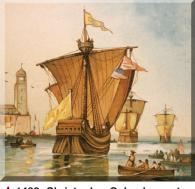

1904: The 13th Dalai Lama fled as British troops entered the Tibetan capital. Lhasa

1940: Lithuania was formally annexed by the Soviet Union as the Lithuanian Soviet Socialist Republic

2000: Former President Suharto of Indonesia was indicted on charges of embezzling \$570 million

2009: An outbreak of pneumonic plague in Qinghai, China, killed two people
