▲ 1851: Isaac Singer was granted a patent on his sewing machine

1848: George Stephenson, builder of the world's first practical steam locomotive. *The Rocket*. died

1908: The first Model T Ford rolled off the factory floor in Detroit

1944: The first "PLUTO" (Pipe Line Under the Ocean) supplying petrol from Britain to the Allied forces in France, went into operation

2009: The Russian navy was deployed to find the MV Arctic Sea, a missing cargo ship reportedly hijacked in the Baltic Sea three weeks earlier
