1057: Scottish king Macbeth, whose life was the basis for Shakespeare's play, was killed by the son of King Duncan, who had been murdered by Macbeth

1914: The first ship sailed through the newly-built Panama Canal

1969: The legendary Woodstock festival began in upstate New York

2009: A powerful suicide car bomb attack outside NATO's headquarters in Kabul, Afghanistan, killed at least seven people and injured around 100
