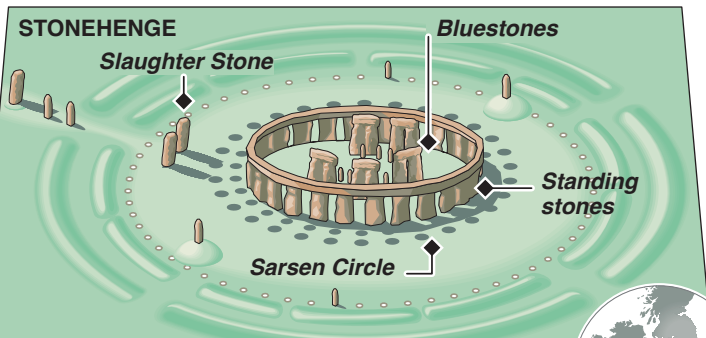


Wooden “sister” of Stonehenge discovered



■ **Neolithic “henge”:** Circular monument built over 4,200 years ago, 900 metres north-west of Stonehenge. Roughly 25m in diameter – almost same size as circle of standing stones at Stonehenge

■ **Construction:** Consists of 24 wooden obelisks, each around 75cm in diameter and up to 8m high. Circle of obelisks enclosed by inner ditch and probable outer bank
