- WikiLeaks: Co-founded in 2006 by 35-year-old Australian Julian Assange
 2006: Posts Standard Operating
- Procedures for prisoners in Camp Delta at Guantanamo Bay. Allegedly
- confirms use of psychological torture

 2007: Exposes \$3 billion corruption scam to swing vote in Kenya elections
- 2010: Makes public video of U.S. helicopter attack in Iraqi capital that kills 12 civilians, including two journalists from Reuters. WikiLeaks labels attack as collateral murder
- Organization: Web site run by Sunshine Press with core group of some six full-time volunteers. Hosted on servers in Sweden and Belgium, with "mirrors" around world
