France declares war against Al Qaeda

France has declared war on Al Qaeda, and matched its fighting words with a first attack on a base camp of the terror network's North African branch, after militants killed a French aid worker taken hostage in April

AI GERIA

- AQIM formed in 1998 as Salafist Group for Preaching and Combat. Changed name in 2007
- Thought to number 500 fighters, led by *Abu Musab*Abdul Wadud
- AQIM operates in vast, semi-arid *Sahel* region where security is sparse
- Mounted series of highprofile attacks on *Algeria's* government and security forces in 2007
- More recently, group has carried out kidnappings and attacks on Western targets, mainly in *Mauritania*
