

# Volt faces Leaf in EV showdown

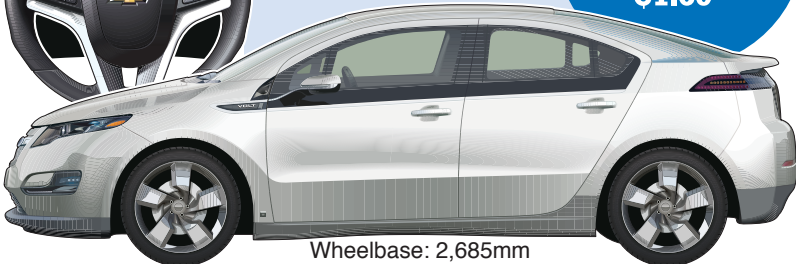
The Nissan Leaf is the first mass produced zero-emission electric vehicle while the Chevy Volt counters so-called "range anxiety" with a small petrol engine which generates electricity, extending its range to 480 kilometres
