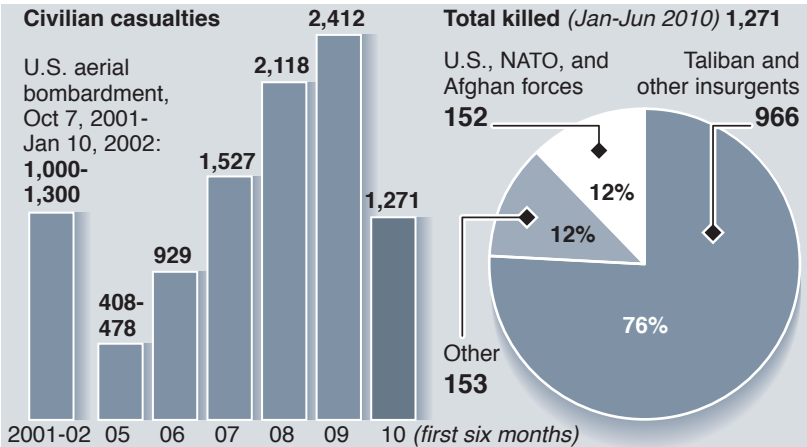


Afghan civilian deaths up by a third

The number of civilians killed or wounded in the Afghan conflict rose 31% in the first six months of 2010. Almost 1,300 civilians were killed and another 1,997 civilians were injured according to the latest UN report
