## ▲ 1440: Eton School was founded by King Henry VI of England

**356BC:** Alexander the Great, who conquered Greece, Persia and much of India before he was 33. was born

1870: Italian troops took control of the Papal States, leading to the unification of Italy

**1946:** The first Cannes Film Festival, scheduled to debut in 1939 but delayed by World War II, opened

2009: Army troops killed more than 140 Shiite Houthi rebels in northern Yemen after they attempted to take over the government palace in the mountain city of Saada
