
UN reports over 500 rapes in eastern Congo

The United Nations says that over 500 systematic rapes have been committed by armed combatants in eastern Congo since late July - more than double the number previously reported - and accepts partial responsibility for not protecting citizens

Mission in DRC (MONUSCO) is world's largest peace mission, costing over \$1bn per year

Mission, formerly MONUC, set up in 1999 to monitor Lusaka Ceasefire Agreement

- 20.000 troops from 50 countries cover area half as big as Western Europe
- ▶ 1,500 troops recently withdrawn due to pressure from Congolese president Joseph Kabila, who wants to see all UN forces out by 2011
- MONUC mired in controversy in 2009 for backing state security forces accused of killing hundreds of civilians
