- for Liberal Democratic Party ■ 1993: Leaves LDP. Joins fledgling
- opposition movement ■ 1998: Becomes president of
- Liberal Party ■ 2003: Merges Liberal Party with
- Democratic Party of Japan bloc representing former socialists and polititians disgruntled with LDP
- 2007: Leads DPJ to landslide victory in upper house elections
- May 2009: Resigns as DPJ president over funding scandal
- Aug: Helps engineer DPJ victory in lower house elections which oust LDP after half a century of almost
- unbroken rule Sep 2010: Loses party leadership vote to Premier Naoto Kan - later plays
- key role in pressuring Kan to resign Oct 6, 2011: Ozawa, 69, goes on trial on charges of breaking political fundraising laws
