

Three super-efficient cars win X Prize

Three teams – two American and one Swiss – shared a \$10 million jackpot awarded by the X Prize Foundation for cars that can achieve 100MPGe (42.5km/litre or energy equivalent) and which can be mass-produced

\$5 million

Edison2, *Very Light Car*:

Four-person sedan weighs in at only **377kg**.

Fuel: **E85 ethanol, 102.5MPGe.**

Range: **482km, 0-100km/h in 14 seconds.**

Built out of steel and aluminum with gull-wing doors



\$2.5 million

Li-ion Motors, *Wave 2*: Two-seater, electric vehicle powered by lithium batteries. Weight: **987kg**.

Range: **161km**. Fuel efficiency: **187MPGe**. 0-100km/h in **14.7 secs**



\$2.5 million

X-tracer: Two-seater, motorcycle-like electric vehicle. Weight: **651kg**.

Range: **161km**. Fuel efficiency: **197MPGe**. 0-100km/h in **6.6 secs**
