

Iran fears trigger massive arms deal

The Obama administration has agreed to sell \$123 billion worth of U.S. weapons to four Gulf states in a bid to counter Iran's military power. The deal is the biggest foreign sale of American arms ever negotiated



■ **Saudi Arabia:** 85 new F-15 warplanes, upgrade 70 existing F-15s

■ **UAE:** THAAD and Patriot missile defence systems. Helicopters, transports, UAVs

■ **Oman:** 18 new F-16 jets, upgrade 12 F-16s and air defence system

■ **Kuwait:** Replace 39 F-18 aircraft. Upgrade Patriot missile systems
