North Korea's ruling Communist party is to hold its first conference since 1980. It is thought likely it will choose a new leadership and anoint an heir to the dynasty as the health of "Dear Leader" Kim Jong-il deteriorates

WORKERS PARTY OF KOREA

Founded Oct 10, 1945. Source of national ideology of *Juche*, or self-reliance, promulgated by state founder *Kim Il-sung*, father of *Kim*

Jong-il

Kim is expected to replace five-member panel of *Political Bureau Presidium* – highest body of party leadership structure. Kim is only surviving member – since 1980 all others, including "Eternal President" Kim II-sung, have died

CABINET

Headed by Premier *Choe Yong-rim.*Theoretically controls

executive ministries and oversees

PARLIAMENT

Supreme People's Assembly endorses party decisions. Presided over by nominal head of state Kim Yong-nam
