Mark Webber:

Anticipates *Red Bull's* car will be fastest and best suited to track. Last year Webber crashed out with brake failure after 45 laps





Lewis Hamilton:

Drove his *McLaren-Mercedes* to victory last year. Hopes two months of engineering work will improve performance on high-downforce circuit

Jenson Button:

McLaren driver hasn't won in 10 races but could still retain his world champion status thanks to his consistent points gathering

Sebastian Vettel: Trails Red Bull team-mate Webber by 24 points. But with five races to go, and 25 points for a win, Vettel remains confident



Fernando Alonso:

Ferrari driver enters Sunday's race with momentum, having delighted Italian fans with his victory at Monza two weeks ago
