Brazil's Rousseff looks set for presidency

Frontrunner still popular despite ethics scandal involving one of her former top aides. Has vowed to continue Lula's stable economic policies that have boosted Brazil's growth

Despite attempts to exploit corruption allegations against his rival, Serra's campaign has been largely ineffective at overturning Rousseff's big lead due to Lula's huge popularity
