
Nigeria turns 50 amid deep social divisions

Inter-communal violence in Nigeria has killed around 13,500 people since the end of military rule in 1999. It resurfaced in a major way earlier this year when political uncertainty in the period before President Umaru Yar'Adua's death left the authorities too distracted to deal effectively with it



- Revenge attacks in Kano State kill 30
- Feb 2006: Over 100 killed in rioting in Maiduguri and Onitsha sparked by Muslim protests against Danish cartoons of Prophet Muhammad
- Nov 2008: Clashes following disputed local election trigger two days of rioting which kill 700 in Jos
