■ Mother: Ko Young-hui (d. 2004).

Japanese-born Korean dancer, said to be Kim Jong-il's favourite consort

■ Education: Attended international school in Switzerland until 1998. Studied military science at university in North Korea, 2002-2006

■ Role: In September 2010, Kim is made a four-star general, given senior ruling party posts, and put in charge of North Korea's secret police

■ Succession: Given Kim Jong-un's youth, his uncle, *Jang Sung-taek*, is believed to have been entrusted with caretaker role to oversee smooth transfer of power
