- UK, for developing in-vitro fertilization (IVF), which has helped millions of infertile couples to have children
- 2009: Elizabeth Blackburn, Carol Greider, Jack Szostak, U.S., for discovery of how body protects chromosomes housing vital genetic code, and furthering understanding of ageing process, cancer and stem cells
- 2008: Harald zur Hausen, GER, for discovery of human papilloma viruses. Françoise Barré-Sinoussi, Luc Montagnier, FRA, for discovery of human immunodeficiency virus
- 2007: Mario Capecchi, Oliver Smithies, U.S., Martin Evans, UK, for work on introducing genetic changes in mice using embryonic stem cells
- 2006: Andrew Fire, Craig Mello, U.S. Discovery of mechanism for controlling flow of genetic information
