

FIFA suspends executives in corruption probe

A FIFA Ethics Committee is investigating alleged vote-selling by six current and former members of the Executive Committee, leaving the bidding to host the 2018 and 2022 World Cups in turmoil. It will also follow up allegations that two of the bidding nations were in collusion
