

Tariq Aziz Iraq's former Deputy Premier, for many years the public face of Saddam Hussein's Irag, has been sentenced to death by Irag's Supreme Court

- village near Mosul, Studies English literature before career in journalism. Edits main Baath Party newspaper
- 1970s: Named information minister
- 1977: Joins Revolutionary Command Council - senior Baath committee ruling Iraq - becoming deputy prime minister in 1979
- 1980-88: Helps win U.S. support for Iraq in its war with Iran 1990: Recognisable figure in world
- media following invasion of Kuwait ■ 1991: Famously refuses to accept letter from then U.S. President
- George Bush to Saddam Hussein, signalling inevitability of first Gulf War 2003: Gives himself up to U.S.
- forces two weeks after fall of Saddam Oct 2010: Sentenced to hang for persecuting Shiite political parties
