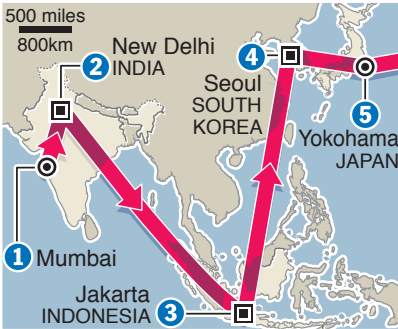


President Obama's Asian itinerary



1 INDIA, Nov 6: Arrives Mumbai.

Stays at **Taj Hotel** where he will meet survivors of 2008 terrorist attack. Delivers address at **U.S.-India Business Council**, where American business delegation hopes to clinch \$9.4bn in deals

Nov 7: Participates in **Diwali** celebrations, delivers keynote speech on democracy before departing for New Delhi

2 New Delhi, Nov 8: Visits tomb of Mughal **Emperor Humayun** and Raj Ghat memorial to **Mahatma Gandhi**. Addresses Parliament and meets with President **Pratibha Patil** before attending state dinner hosted by Prime Minister **Manmohan Singh**

3 INDONESIA, Nov 9: Flies to Jakarta. Meets with President **Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono** and attends state dinner

Nov 10: Visits **Istiqlal Mosque**, delivers outdoor speech on themes of partnership, democracy and outreach. Departs for Seoul

4 SOUTH KOREA, Nov 11: Bilateral talks with President **Hu Jintao** of China in Seoul. Obama to address U.S. troops stationed in South Korea

Nov 12: Final day of G20. Obama to hold press conference with South Korea's President **Lee Myung-bak**. Departs for Japan

5 JAPAN, Nov 13: Obama addresses business summit – part of **APEC** meeting in Yokohama, holds talks with Japan's Prime Minister **Naoto Kan**

Nov 14: One-on-one meetings with Russian President **Dmitry Medvedev** and Australian Prime Minister **Julia Gillard**. Visits **Great Buddha of Kamakura** before returning to U.S.
