- 1989: Martial law declared in Burma.
- Suu Kyi placed under house arrest

 1990: Suu Kyi's National League
 for Democracy Party wins 392 of 485
- seats but Junta refuses to yield power

 1991: Suu Kyi awarded Nobel
- Peace Prize

 1995: Released from house arrest
- but movements restricted

 2000: Returned to house arrest under
- State Protection Law. Released in 2002
- 2003: Detained again following clashes between her supporters and pro-junta demonstrators
- monks marching past her house in first public appearance since 2003

2007: Greets protesting Buddhist

- 2008: House arrest extended for another year
- 2009: Sentenced to 18 months further house arrest after uninvited visitor swims to her house
- Nov 7, 2010: NLD boycotts election won by military-backed party
- Nov 13: Suu Kyi expected to be released as house arrest term expires
