(PdL), 238 seats: Ruling party founded by Silvio Berlusconi and Gianfranco Fini in 2009. by merging Forza Italia party with "post-Fascist" Alleanza Nazionale



Lega Nord, 59 seats: Second largest party in ruling coalition, led by Umberto Bossi. Minister for Institutional Reforms in Berlusconi's cabinet



(PD), 206 seats: Largest opposition party. Dario Franceschini - party's Leader in Chamber of Deputies - submitted no-confidence motion



33 seats: Gianfranco Fini, speaker of lower house. Quit PdL in July. depriving Berlusconi of absolute majority. Fini is demanding prime minister's resignation Mixed Group*: 35 _



Cristiani e di Centro (UDC), 35 seats: Led by Pier Ferdinando Casini. UDC has joined with FLI and two other parties in abstention alliance. which controls 84 votes



24 seats: Led by Antonio Di Pietro. anti-corruption party is member of PD-led coalition
