

Qantas incidents

Up to 40 engines on a global fleet of 20 Airbus A380 planes may need to be replaced on Qantas, Lufthansa and Singapore Airlines



■ **Aug 30:** Explosive “uncontained failure” of **Rolls-Royce RB211** engine on Qantas Boeing 747 during flight to San Francisco

■ **Nov 4:** Qantas A380 with 466 passengers makes emergency landing in Singapore after Rolls-Royce **Trent 900** engine disintegrates. Qantas grounds entire A380 fleet

■ **Nov 5:** Qantas Boeing 747 makes emergency landing in Singapore due to failure of RB211 engine

■ **Nov 15:** Qantas Boeing 747 bound for Buenos Aires with 220 passengers and crew forced to return to Sydney due to smoke in cockpit

■ **Nov 16:** Qantas Boeing 747 with 171 passengers makes emergency landing in Johannesburg after bird strike in an engine

■ **Nov 16:** Qantas Boeing 717 hit by lightning en route from Alice Springs to Darwin – continues to destination
